How long is the show? A standard show is about 25-30 minutes. We can do longer or shorter shows based on client's request. In a typical show the dancer will use veils, canes, wings, sword, zills, shamadan (a chandelier that is balanced in the head with lit candles). The dancer will invite guests to dance during the second part of the show unless the client specifies otherwise.

Is it appropriate for children? Yes, a belly dance show is family oriented. Children often love to dance and participate.

What about the music? The belly dancer provides a CD with the music and the venue should provide the sound system (louder is better). Usually the dancer will stay out of sight until the CD starts playing.

What kind of music is used? Depending on your preference, music can range from classical Arabic to modern pop. Our music collection includes music from popular Lebanese, Egyptian and Persian singers.

Is tipping appropriate? Yes. Unless the host has requested otherwise, the dancer will gladly accept tips. Tips may be tucked into the dancer's belt, shoulder strap, or thrown above her head as a "money shower" or just added to the payment.

What if I need more than one belly dancer? We will be happy to provide you with as many dancers that you request. We are company of professional dancers ready to create the show of your dreams. We can add other dance styles as well. Some popular choices are Bollywood, Tango, Salsa, Samba, etc.

How far in advance should I make the booking? It is advised that you book a show at least 2 weeks in advance. We do our best to fit in last minute shows.

What kind of payment accepted? Payment is collected most of the time right after the show. We prefer cash as a form of payment. Paypal payments can be arranged for deposits through this website.
